**COMPARABILITY OF SERVICES OF
NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND TITLE I**

In accordance with comparability of services No Child Left Behind Title I, the following will apply:

1. A district-wide salary schedule will prevail.
2. The Churchill County School District strives to provide an equal educational opportunity for all students. The District recognizes that the size of schools and the grade level served by schools must be considered in allocating instructional staff and dollars per student for the purchase of supplies, materials, and equipment.

Instructional Classroom Staffing: All schools within the District that serve non-departmentalized grade levels, i.e., grades kindergarten through sixth (6th) grade, may be staffed differently with instructional personnel using a different staffing ratio because of school size. The District recognizes that school size may dictate different teacher/pupil ratios or salary expenditures to provide comparable educational opportunities for all students.

Whenever Title I funds are used to hire instructional classroom personnel, such personnel will be in addition to those allocated in the above-stated manner.

Supplies, Materials, and Equipment: School discretionary funds will be allocated to schools by formula for the purchase of supplies, materials, equipment and other operational costs. The District's allocation formulas recognize that school size may dictate larger/smaller expenditures per pupil at some schools to provide comparable educational opportunities for all students.

Whenever Title I funds are used for supplies, materials, equipment or other operational costs, they will be in addition to District fund allocations.
