

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES
CHURCHILL COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT****PUBLIC APPEARANCES AT OPEN BOARD MEETINGS**

The Board of Trustees welcomes all persons interested in any or all matters related to the schools at meetings of the Churchill County School Board.

It is recommended that persons wishing to communicate with the Board of Trustees make such a request (preferably in writing) to the superintendent at least one (1) week in advance of the board meeting. If appropriate and approved by the Board President, the superintendent shall place the item on the board agenda for its proper consideration.

During an open board meeting, any individual or group may address the board of trustees concerning any subject within the board's jurisdiction and subject to the following rules:

1. Before any action on an item on the agenda, the president of the board shall call for public comment of that item.
2. During the Public Comment section of the agenda, the president of the board shall call for public comment on any subject within the jurisdiction of the board.
3. Interested persons will be heard by the Board of Trustees under proper rules of propriety.
4. An individual who wishes to address the board or who is called upon by the president to address the board, should step to the podium, give their name and then direct their remarks to the board.
5. Any discussion by an individual or group may be limited in time at the discretion of the president of the board. Time limits shall be implemented uniformly.
6. If members of the public present complaints against individual employees of Churchill County School District, the members of the board shall advise them of the proper procedure for registering such complaints under board policy P4138.
7. Individuals or groups making presentations to the board of trustees are encouraged to be courteous and proper. Boisterous conduct and remarks which are abusive, profane or obscene will not be tolerated. The president of the board may terminate the right of any speaker to continue if he violates this regulation.
