**SECONDARY SCHOOL GRADE PLACEMENT**

For purposes of grade placement and grade movement or promotion at the Churchill County High School, the following will apply:

- A CCHS student is considered a 9th grade student (freshman), if he/she has completed the 8th grade and earned 1.5 credits of Math, 1.5 credits of English, 1 credit of Science, and 1 credit of Social Studies by the end of his/her 8th grade year.
- A CCHS student is considered to be a 10th grade student (sophomore), if he/she has been in attendance at CCHS or another accredited high school for a minimum of two semesters.
- A CCHS student is considered an 11th grade student (junior), if he/she has been in attendance at CCHS or another accredited high school for a minimum of four semesters.
- A CCHS student is considered a 12th grade student (senior), if he/she has been in attendance at CCHS or another accredited high school for a minimum of six semesters.

Exceptional circumstances relative to the number of credits earned or semesters attended may be considered by the Superintendent and approved by the Board of Trustees.
