**GRADUATION POLICY – ADULT HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAM**

The Churchill County School District shall issue an adult standard diploma to a student who:

- A. Withdrew from high school before his/her graduation and was not eligible to graduate with his/her class;
- B. Has passed all required end-of-course examinations;
- C. Has earned or waived the units of credit required by the Churchill County School District; and,
- D. Is 18 years of age or over at the time of the award.

**Minimum Credit Required**

Arts and Humanities	1
English	4
Health Education	1/2
Mathematics	3
Science	2
Use of Computers	1/2
Electives	<u>7 1/2</u>
Total	20 1/2

If a person demonstrates a competency of the use of computers, he/she is not required to take the course of study in the use of computers and must earn only a total of 12 1/2 units in required core courses and a total of 20 credits.
