**School Learning Strategist**

**As a school strategist you would be expected to support all teachers in both grades in any subject area needed.**

**The school strategist will be required to meet monthly with all strategists from the district for coaching training and to work as a team.**

**The school strategist would work with the district learning strategist to ensure that the ELA and math (Eureka) curriculum sequencing is used, Read Well is being implemented with fidelity, Being a Writer is implemented, MathBlazer, Zearn, etc, as well as best teaching practices are being used and needed support is given.**

**The school strategist would be required to assist with the Literacy Plan, sit on the Site Data Team, and assist with the School Performance Plan.**

**Oversee the site literacy plan to include yearly revisions. Gather, analyze, and lead staff in collaborative discussion and use of data.**

**Provide and/or coordinate training of classroom teachers to provide intensive instruction in reading to identified deficient readers which would improve the instruction for not only deficient readers, but all readers.**

**Oversee fulfillment of notification/monitoring/timelines of deficient readers. The strategist must be able to communicate with teachers and ensure/facilitate completion (by teachers) of the documents required of SB391 (notification letters, ILIPS, progress monitoring reports etc).**

**The strategist will facilitate the Parent education/advocacy component. The strategist must inform parents of the law and interact with parents by hosting additional Family Literacy classes as well as provide opportunities for families to help their children at home. The strategist must also spearhead the Family Literacy and math nights.**

**School strategist will be responsible for keeping FOSS Kits at their school current with adequate science supplies.**

**Each school learning strategist would be compensated \$5,000 for the year, \$2,500 paid at the end of each semester (December and May).**
